15. CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS:

A. VICE MAYOR JULIEN'S REPORT:

1. VICE MAYOR JULIEN WISHED EVERYONE A GOOD EVENING AND INVITED THE COMMUNITY TO A WORKSHOP HOSTED BY THE COMMISSION ON STATUS OF WOMEN AND HIMSELF ON THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 28, AT THE MCDONALD CENTER FROM 7:00 P.M. TO 9:00 P.M. SOME OF THE DISCUSSIONS, AND SOME OF THE TOPICS THAT THEY WILL BE DISCUSSING, ARE IDENTITY THEFT WHICH IS VERY PREVALENT IN THE COMMUNITY. VICE MAYOR JULIEN INDICATED THAT WE ARE GOING TO HAVE INDIVIDUALS THERE THAT CAN HELP YOU WITH THIS SITUATION. OTHER TOPICS INCLUDE FORECLOSURES, WHICH OBVIOUSLY ARE RUNNING RAMPANT THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE UNITED STATES, REVERSE MORTGAGES, AND A FEW OTHER ITEMS. VICE MAYOR JULIEN ENCOURAGED EVERYONE TO PLEASE COME AND PARTICIPATE WITH US.

VICE MAYOR JULIEN WISHED TO READ SOMETHING FROM THE MINUTES OF THE TUESDAY, APRIL 20, 2004 MEETING, WHICH HE INDICATED THAT HE WAS NOT ON THAT COUNCIL AND IT SAID "UPON RENEWAL OF OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE THE CITY WOULD VIEW THE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE WITH A LIGHT MORE FAVORABLE TO DIAMOND'S CABARET IN AN AIR OF BENEVOLENCE AND COOPERATION. RENEWAL OF THE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE IS NOT GUARANTEED AND THE BEHAVIOR OF THIS ESTABLISHMENT IS SUBJECT TO FUTURE DETERMINATION IN THE FUTURE AS TO WHETHER OR NOT IT IS JUSTIFIED". VICE MAYOR JULIEN STATED THAT IS ONE EXCERPT. ALSO, AT THE LAST MEETING, TWO WEEKS AGO, IT WAS STATED THAT ANONYMOUS LETTERS OR ANONYMOUS COMPLAINTS SHOULD NOT BE TAKEN SERIOUSLY BECAUSE ANYONE WHO IS COMPLAINING ABOUT SOMETHING SHOULD HAVE THE GUTS TO WRITE THEIR NAME ON IT. VICE MAYOR JULIEN INDICATED THAT, UNFORTUNATELY, WE LIVE IN A

A. VICE MAYOR JULIEN'S REPORT (CONTINUED):

TIME WHEN PEOPLE ARE AFRAID TO SPEAK UP AND SOMETIMES ANONYMOUS LETTERS ARE THE ONLY THING THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT OR COMMUNITY HAVE TO GO ON, OR GO BY SO THAT THEY CAN ACTUALLY BECOME AWARE OF SOMETHING THAT IS GOING ON. VICE MAYOR JULIEN WISHED TO READ JUST ONE LITTLE EXCERPT FROM THE SUNDAY, MARCH 21, 2004 MIAMI HERALD, WHERE, IN IT, IT STATES "THE CLUBS PROBLEMS STARTED LAST MONTH WHEN NORTH MIAMI BEACH MAYOR JEFFREY MISHCON RECEIVED AN ANONYMOUS ENVELOPE". VICE MAYOR JULIEN EMPHASIZED ANONYMOUS, AND SOMETIMES PEOPLE ARE AFRAID TO SPEAK UP BECAUSE THEY FEEL RETRIBUTION AND SOMETIMES WE NEED TO TAKE AND WEIGH WHAT THE COMPLAINT IS AND ACT ACCORDINGLY. THEREAFTER, VICE MAYOR JULIEN WISHED EVERYBODY A PLEASANT EVENING.

THIS IS A FESTIVAL OF THE WHOLE COMMUNITY AND IT IS REALLY GOING TO BE TERRIFIC AND WE ARE REALLY HOPING THAT THIS WILL BE SUCCESSFUL.

EVERYBODY GETS A PRIZE THERE, AND THERE IS A LUNCH THAT IS SUPPLIED. IT IS REALLY TERRIFIC AND MAYOR MARIN INVITED EVERYBODY TO BE THERE AT 9:30, AND YOU REALLY WILL ENJOY IT.

THE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE TALKS ABOUT LEWD AND LASCIVIOUS AND THAT IS WHAT THE ANONYMOUS LETTER REFERRED TO. MAYOR MARIN ADDED THAT HE REMEMBERED SEEING THE TAPE.

VICE MAYOR JULIEN INDICATED THAT THE REST OF THE RECORD THAT HE DID NOT READ WAS DONE TO SAVE TIME. FOR EXAMPLE, AFTER THE WORD ENVELOPE IT SAID "THAT IT CONTAINED A POSTCARD ADVERTISING DIAMOND'S CABARET LOCATED AT THE DIRECTIONS TO A WEBSITE".

MAYOR MARIN EXPLAINED THAT, INCLUDED IN THE WEBSITE WERE LEWD AND LASCIVIOUS ACTS BEING PERFORMED, AND THAT IS WHY THEY LOST THEIR OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE. THAT IT WAS NOT FOR SHOOTING, STABBING OR FIGHTING. IT WAS FOR LEWD AND LASCIVIOUS ACTS WHICH IS DIFFERENT FROM A SHOOTING.
