COUNCILMAN JULIEN KNEW THE ONE ON THE FENCE AT GREYNOLDS PARK HAS BEEN REMOVED BUT NOW HE SEES ONE ON THE FENCE AT WEST DIXIE HIGHWAY AND N.E.159TH STREET, AND HE WOULD LIKE THE SAME TO HAPPEN THERE AND HE WOULD LIKE TO ASK, AS OUR CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS ARE GOING THROUGHOUT THE CITY, IF THEY SEE CAMPAIGN SIGNS ON FENCES OR ON VACANT PROPERTY HE WOULD LIKE FOR THOSE TO BE REMOVED. COUNCILMAN JULIEN INDICATED THE REASON BEING WAS BECAUSE HE DID NOT SEE THIS HAPPENING IN OTHER CITIES. IT DOES NOT HAPPEN IN AVENTURA, IT DOES NOT HAPPEN IN MIAMI SHORES, IT DOES NOT HAPPEN IN MIAMI LAKES, IT DOES NOT HAPPEN IN CORAL GABLES, AND HE REALLY WOULD NOT LIKE TO SEE IT HERE IN NORTH MIAMI BEACH EITHER. HE DID NOT THINK WE ARE THE DUMPING GROUND FOR OTHER PEOPLE TO START PUTTING CAMPAIGN SIGNS AND THAT GOES FOR HIMSELF AS WELL IF NEXT YEAR ASSUMING, IF ANY OF HIS SIGNS ARE FOUND ON A FENCE HE WOULD NEVER AUTHORIZE THAT BUT EVERY NOW AND AGAIN, YOU HAVE SOME OVERZEALOUS CAMPAIGN WORKERS. COUNCILMAN JULIEN STATED THAT IF ANY OF HIS SIGNS ARE FOUND ON A PROPERTY THAT IT DOES NOT BELONG ON HE DOES NOT EVEN NEED A PHONE CALL FROM CODE ENFORCEMENT, HE WANTS IT TO BE REMOVED.
