

## WHERE TO REGISTER

Parents or legal guardians may register children into a North Miami Beach Parks & R.E.C. After School Program by visiting one of the following locations:

- **The Ronald A. Silver “Y.E.S.” Youth Enrichment Services Center**  
17051 NE 19th Avenue.  
Registration begins on Monday, August 8, 2016, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Payments can be made in the form of check, money order, Visa or MasterCard.
- **The North Miami Beach Parks & R.E.C. Department Administrative Office, 17051 NE 19th Avenue.**  
Registration begins on Monday, August 8, 2016, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Payments can be made in the form of cash, check, money order, Visa or MasterCard.
- **The Local Community Center of your choice where the specific After School Program is held; Highland Village, Uleta Park, Washington Park, & Y.E.S. Center.** Registration begins on Monday, August 22, 2016, between the hours of 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Payment must be made in the form of check or money order only, and made payable to the “City of North Miami Beach.” Sorry, no cash accepted at these sites.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All North Miami Beach residents must present proof of residency at the time of registration. A current utility bill with the parent’s name and address on it, along with picture identification, will be accepted as proof. The registration fee is a one-time, non-refundable fee per child that includes supplemental insurance. **PROGRAMS RUN IN FOUR (4) WEEK SESSIONS.** For additional information on paying by session, please contact your child’s facility supervisor, or contact the Parks & R.E.C. ## GENERAL INFORMATION

The City of North Miami Beach Parks & R.E.C. Department's after school programs have been designed with the following goals and objectives:

- △ To provide an after school program for children in grades K through 5, Monday through Friday, from 2:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.
- △ To provide a variety of recreational, leisure, and sports related programs to maintain interest and create an atmosphere where each child's needs for self-expression can be met.
- △ To provide trained staff to help us achieve these goals.

## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Weekly and Daily Highlights include Arts and Crafts Activities, Active and Passive Sports, Clubs, Daily Snacks, Homework Time, Bi-monthly Special Events, and Tutoring.

## TRANSPORTATION

Transportation is provided, with some exceptions, from North Miami Beach area schools, which include Aventura Waterways K-8 Center, Fulford Elementary, Greynolds Park Elementary, Oak Grove Elementary, Ojus Elementary, Sabal Palm Elementary, and John F. Kennedy Middle School.

**Please note:** Parents are responsible for daily pick-up by 6:00 p.m. After 6:00 p.m. a late fee of \$5.00 per fifteen (15) minutes will be assessed.

## TEACHER PLANNING DAYS

On Teacher Planning Days (T.P.D.) all N.M.B. After School programs are available from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at a cost of \$18.00 for registered N.M.B. Residents, and \$21.00 for Non-Residents. T.P.D.'s are also available for children not in our After School Program for a cost of \$25.00 per day, and a one-time, non-refundable registration fee of \$40.00 for N.M.B. Residents and \$60.00 for Non-residents. For teacher planning days an additional \$5.00 field trip fee will be charged.


