Congresswoman Frederica Wilson will Award Funds from the Omnibus Bill to the City of North Miami Beach during a Check Presentation Ceremony

North Miami Beach, FL – April 11, 2022 – Florida Congresswoman Frederica Wilson will award funds from the Omnibus Bill to the City of North Miami Beach on Tuesday, April 12, 2022. The special check presentation ceremony will be held from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the NMB City Hall Plaza (located at 17011 NE 19th Avenue, North Miami Beach, FL 33162).

During the ceremony, Congresswoman Wilson will present a \$1,141,038 check to the North Miami Beach Mayor, Commissioners, and Office of the City Manager. The City of North Miami Beach will receive this award from the recently passed federal Omnibus Appropriations Bill. The \$1.5 trillion spending bill was signed by President Joe Biden on March 15, 2022 and it aims to fund the federal government for the remainder of fiscal year 2022, which ends September 30th. To celebrate this funding allocation, the NMB Marching Band will perform at the ceremony.

“This comprehensive bill addresses many of the biggest challenges in North Miami Beach. I’m proud to have been part of an initiative that focuses on improving the lives of residents of NMB” said Commissioner Michael Joseph. Commissioner Joseph is a member of the 5,000 Role Models of Excellence and a past scholarship recipient of the organization Congresswoman Wilson started as a Miami-Dade County School Board Member.
