Jones, Haitian Lawyers Association, and community partners will present a Seal and Expungement Redemption Workshop on Thursday, June 23rd, 2022. The workshop will be held from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Ronald A. Silver Youth Enrichment Services (YES) Center located at 17051 NE 19th Avenue, North Miami Beach, FL 33162.

North Miami Beach Commissioner Michael Joseph, Esq. has partnered with State Senator Shervin D. Jones (D-Florida, District 35) to host a Seal and Expungement Redemption Workshop for residents who have found it difficult to find employment due to a criminal record. This workshop is meant to help North Miami Beach residents see if they qualify to have a criminal record sealed or expunged. In turn, attendees will be able to register to vote and meet with consultants who will assist with immigration needs. The goal of the event is to help residents return to the workforce and exercise their right to vote.
