## **The City of North Miami Beach will launch a new NMB Line Route E**

**North Miami Beach, FL – October 21, 2022** – The City of North Miami Beach will launch a new NMB Line Route E which will transport residents from the Golden Glades Multimodal Transportation Facility to Aventura Mall. To celebrate the new trolley route, the Public Works Department is hosting a special ribbon cutting ceremony on Monday, October 24, 2022, from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. at City Hall (located at 17011 NE 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue, North Miami Beach, FL 33162).

“We’re beyond proud to launch this new pilot program in North Miami Beach! It’s a way to connect our residents to new destinations without the burden of parking or dealing with traffic.” says **Commissioner Daniela Jean**.

The NMB Line currently offers four routes (A, B, C, and D) which provide residents and visitors with free, safe, and convenient service Monday through Saturday, from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. All trolleys are in full compliance with American with Disabilities Act requirements to ensure that every passenger’s needs are met. The new Route E will provide passengers with instant access to two major hubs:

- **Golden Glades Multimodal Transportation Facility:** which will connect you to Tri-Rail and Miami-Dade Transit buses routes E, 22, 77, 155, 246, 277, and 95.
- **Aventura Mall:** the largest mall in Florida and the third largest mall in the United States! With over 300 stores, this new route will open the doors to new employment opportunities for NMB residents and it will facilitate an easier transportation route to work.

“Our trolley's going to the Golden Glades interchange is beneficial to our residents and employees by helping them get to the Tri-Rail. This will allow them to most importantly, go to and from work, visit family, go to medical appointments, the airports and the shops” says **Commissioner Fortuna Smukler**.
