The City of North Miami Beach forms an Education Compact with Miami-Dade County Public Schools

North Miami Beach, FL – November 15, 2022 – The City of North Miami Beach has partnered with Miami-Dade County Public Schools to bring together each organization's collective resources for the greater benefit of both the students and the citizens of North Miami Beach. The new Education Compact sponsored by Commissioner Daniela Jean was approved at the City Commission Meeting held in October 2022.

Located in northeast Miami-Dade County, the City of North Miami Beach is home to two District facilities – Fulford Elementary School and Greynolds Park Elementary School, with both schools being a part of the North Miami Beach Feeder Pattern which also includes Gertrude K. Edelman/ Sabal Palm Elementary School, John F. Kennedy Middle School and North Miami Beach Senior High School. These schools are geographically located outside of City boundaries and will benefit from this compact.

“As a product of the North Miami Beach feeder pattern it was important for me to lead the collaboration between the City and the Miami-Dade County Public School system to galvanize resources that will elevate and educate the community” says **Commissioner Daniela Jean**.

The commitment between the District and the City to raise academic achievement, and recognizing the importance placed on education by the residents of North Miami Beach, the District and City formed an Education Compact to build on existing programs and innovative ideas which will enhance the lifelong educational opportunities for the entire community.

The areas of focus in this collaboration include: programming that supports education curriculum, enhanced communication of educational and community events; family/parental involvement in education; community/business engagement, enhanced student health and well-being; improved student achievement; school safety; and technology access. In addition, the City will collaborate with the School District to provide space for meetings, graduations and presentations within City facilities. Those facilities include the Julius Littman Theater, the NMB Amphitheater, and the McDonald Center.
