This Uniform Municipal CO/CC Inspection Reporting Form is used to gather trade approvals for Certificate of Occupancy (CO) or Completion (CC). Once validated by the Building Department personnel, the form must be present at the job site for the field inspectors. Inspectors must verify outstanding work listed, and verify all code provisions relating to public safety have been met prior to granting Final approval. Final approvals must be signed on the permit card and submitted at time of application. When all approvals have been obtained, take the signed form back to the Building Department for CO/CC issuance.
