

ORDINANCE NO.2000-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING ARTICLE VI, SECTION 6.02(a) DEFINING EARLY RETIREMENT OF THE RETIREMENT PLAN FOR POLICE OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR THE CODIFICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature, in Chapter 99-1, Laws of Florida, enacted significant amendments to Chapters 175 and 185, Florida Statutes, which govern police and firefighters pension funds; and

WHEREAS, this new legislation makes virtually all provisions of Chapters 175 and 185 expressly applicable to local law plans; and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Plan for Police Officers and Firefighters of the City of North Miami Beach currently complies with or exceeds most of the minimum requirements of Chapters 175 and 185; and

WHEREAS, certain technical amendments were made to the City's plan as required to bring the plan into complete compliance with the new state law pursuant to Ordinance No. 99-8; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Plan's actuary and attorney that another minor technical amendment is required and will have no significant financial impact on the City's Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council now desire to amend the City of North Miami Beach Retirement Plan for Police Officers and Firefighters to incorporate this requirement of Chapters 175 & 185 and to bring the Plan into complete compliance under state law.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of North Miami Beach, Florida.

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. Article VI (**RETIREMENT BENEFITS**) Section 6.02(a) of the Retirement Plan for Police Officers and Firefighters of the City of North Miami Beach is hereby amended as follows:

S.6.02 EARLY RETIREMENT AND RETIREMENT INCOME

(a) Defined - Early retirement under the Plan is retirement from the service of the City, as of the first day of any calendar month prior to the participant's normal retirement date, subsequent to the date he has both attained the age of 45 years and has completed at least fifteen (15) years of credited service, or has attained the age of 50 years and has completed at least ten (10) years of credited service.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid the remainder shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 5. It is the intention of the City Council of the City of North Miami Beach and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of North Miami Beach, Florida. The Sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish this intention and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Section", "Article" or other appropriate word as the codifier may deem fit.
